Set up and manage their own profile

Verifies identity and sets unique identifier

Provide quality and responsive support to the workforce from the beginning steps to ensure access and protection of their data.



Data Verification

The ECE professionals provide documentation to verify the information provided in their profiles (copies of credentials, proof of approved training and degree completion, etc.)

Collects data and provide suite of tools to support processing workflows

Verify data using policies and processes that are equitable and meet NWRA's best practices for verification, classification, and reporting.



Data Accountability

- **The ECE professionals** are engaged and notified along the process.
- **Data System** executes functions and summarized reports for the workforce for licensing compliance, report to quality initiatives, plan and access professional development opportunities, etc.
- **Registry staff** and the **ECE professionals** continue the trusted relationship to ensure their information is maintained current, protected, and appropriately utilized to support their work



Data Reporting & Analysis

The ECE professionals have access to their data and have signed off to use it in aggregated form for policy and advocacy efforts that will support their profession.

Reporting capabilities to aggregate state data

Coordinate with NWRA to become PER approved and include state data in the national dataset.
